The EU's Heads of State called in October 2020 to set up a **European Health Data Space** (EHDS):

As a response, the Member States and the European Commission launched the Joint Action Towards the European Health Data Space (TEHDAS) in February 2021. The major expected outcome of TEHDAS is a sustainable roadmap towards the EHDS implementation to promote the cross-border sharing of health data for secondary use. It **built on the needs and expectations** of national and international stakeholders, citizen engagement and existing infrastructure.
